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#### **January website activity**

We had 280 page views to the "Planning for High School" webinar page in January. (Page views: the number of pages visitors viewed on a given day. A single visitor may view one or more pages. We don't get stats for individual links viewed.)

98% of that web traffic originated from Google. There were 11 from Facebook (live webinar viewers), 7 from the Jeffco webinar flyer, 6 from Jeffco schools and a handful each from other browsers.

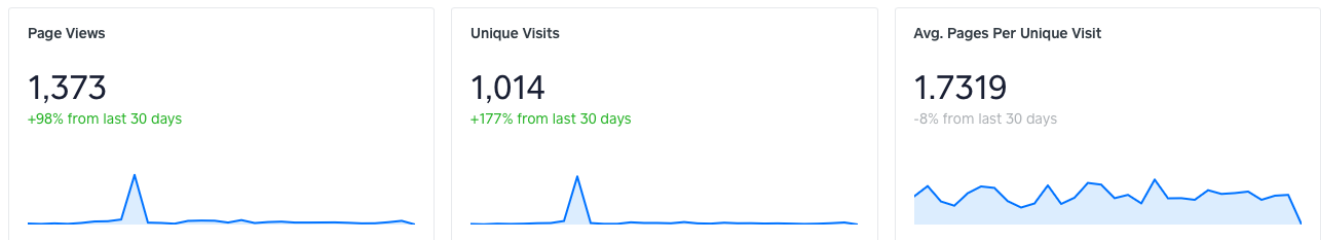
