The GT Dept. will send a registration link and course options home to families of all students on Advanced Learning Plans or in GT Centers on March 1.



**Early Access for Kindergarten Applications Due March 18** The Early Access application is now open. Portfolios are due March 19. Early Access applies to children in the 97th percentile or above on standardized tests and functioning levels typically two years or more above peers. 

# Warren Tech 2022-2023 Application

The Warren Tech application is open through Enroll Jeffco. The priority application deadline is Feb. 11. Check the <u>Warren Tech website</u> for details. Program dates:

- Round 1 Enrollment Window closes Feb. 11.
- Round 1 Lottery offers for Warren Tech are sent to families on April 5. Families must accept or decline the offer by April 8

- Round 2 Enrollment Window for Warren Tech opens Feb. 12 and stays open until August 31. Offers are sent to families if space becomes available.
- Every student who has applied by the Round 1 deadline is considered. After the Round 1 window has closed, students may apply in Round 2 and are considered if space is available. If space is not available, they are placed on the waitlist.
