#### **Enroll Jeffco Opens Jan. 10**

Round one enrollment for the 2022-23 is open at EnrollJeffco. See the flyer for more details (English I Spanish). Round 1 for the 2022-23 school year is open Jan. 10-28. Round 2 opens Feb. 20. Choice application offers will go out in late January.

When evaluating where to enroll, review these JAGC questions to ask schools.

#### New Jeffco PK-12 Students:

- Use the <u>School Finder button</u> to find your neighborhood school and/or other school options.
- Contact the school you are interested in attending to enroll.

Current Jeffco K-12 Students:

• If you wish to change schools during the school year, you will need to submit an administrative transfer request to your current school's principal. Unless your family has recently moved, no administrative transfer is needed in this case.



### Jeffco Virtual Academy 2022-23 **Enrollment Opens Jan. 10**

Students interested in Jeffco Virtual Academy must complete <u>JVA's enrollment process</u> through Enroll Jeffco. Round 1 closes on Jan. 28. New families must promptly complete the enrollment process after applying. All current students, both full-time and part-time, will be contacted in February to select courses for next year. Contact your JVA counselor for questions.



#### Warren Tech 2022-2023 Application

The Warren Tech application is open through Enroll Jeffco. The priority application deadline is Feb. 11. Check the <u>Warren Tech website</u> for details. Warren Tech will host an open house Jan. 27 from 5-8 PM at all campuses. Program dates:

- Round 1 Enrollment Window closes Feb. 11.
- Round 1 Lottery offers for Warren Tech are sent to
- families on April 5. Families must accept or decline the offer by April 8.
- Round 2 Enrollment Window for Warren Tech opens Feb. 12 and stays open until August 31. Offers are sent to families if space becomes available.
- Every student who has applied by the Round 1 deadline is considered. After the Round 1 window has closed, students may apply in Round 2 and are considered if space is available. If space is not available, they are placed on the waitlist.



#### Jeffcon Student Technology Conference Jan. 28

Jeffcon is an annual student convention for high school students hosted by the Jeffco IT Dept. Students can explore technologies and jobs in the industry. Students will learn from real world IT professionals about their jobs and available career paths and have opportunities for scholarships, internships and prizes.
